Milestones

Merger and Multisite

In 2023, we merged with Centerpoint Church, and what a privilege and joy that has been to work with and come to know new staff members and an entire church family. One church in two locations! With the launch of a second campus and the growth of Harbor, we have seen God do amazing things within that location and among the people there. Because of your consistent generosity throughout 2022, we were able to:

- Provide severances for Centerpoint's staff
- Revitalize the campus for our Easter launch

Early Learning Center

Through the hard work of many, in 2023 we were able to take our ELC from a childcare facility to a fully licensed early learning center, employing teachers and staff and offering our local community a robust, nurturing Christian education. This investment has increased local engagement with families and enabled record enrollment in our program.

Missions

We have deepened our relationships with our global partners and sent more people on short-term trips than ever before. We have also leaned into our local partners, strengthening our ties with Living Hope Bible Church, Generate Hope, Little Elementary, Haven Clothing, and Mission Arvada. Your generosity will also send Harbor's James and Jessica Gay to Greece to serve with One Heart in Athens starting in January. As we seek to Make Jesus Tangible, we are overwhelmed at the kingdom impact God has allowed Harbor to be a part of.

2024 Vision

As we wrap up 2023, we see that God has provided unprecedented growth in so many areas. That said, due to these sizable investments, our cash reserves are depleted.

2023 Giving Comments

- 1 Giving in Tithes and Offerings at Westminster is outpacing projections by 7%. However, Arvada giving is lower than projected by 33%. Overall, Harbor giving is 6% lower than the forecast.
- 2 Facility overages result from the increased costs of renovating the Arvada campus and the ongoing maintenance costs of running both campuses.
- **3** The costs of revamping the ELC, in coordination with its closure at the beginning of the year, necessitated higher expenses than originally anticipated. The quality of the program has grown tremendously and we anticipate breaking even by late spring 2024.
