Main Idea

Key Scriptures

Start talking.

Start sharing.

- What has gotten in the way of believing those things?
- How does believing believing who Jesus says you are, help define what He has called you to do?

Start doing.

- Joel mentioned several "high level" things Jesus wants us all to do. Re-listen to the list he describes (<https://harborchurch.life>) and identify those that connect most to you.
- What is one step ahead you will take toward that calling?
