Bold In Witness (Week 1) LifeNotes

Main Idea

Belief in, and an experience with Jesus, transforms us into bold fanatics.

Key Scriptures

While walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter) and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea, for they were fisherman. And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." Matthew 4:18-19

The priests and the captain of the temple guard and the Sadducees came up to Peter and John while they were speaking to the people. They were greatly disturbed because the apostles were teaching the people, proclaiming in Jesus the resurrections of the dead. They seized Peter and John and, because it was evening, they put them in jail until the next day. Acts 4:1-3

Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them: "Rulers and elders of the people! If we are being called to a count today for an act of kindness shown to a man who was lame and are being asked how he was healed, then know this, you and all the people of Israel: It is by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed. Jesus is "the stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone.' Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved." Acts 4:8-12

The members of the council were amazed when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, for they could see that they were ordinary men with no special training in the Scriptures. They also recognized them as men who had been with Jesus. Acts 4:12-13

Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. Acts 4:29

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age. Matthew 28:19-20

Start doing.

 Pastor Joel mentioned we need to: Spend time with Jesus, Ask Jesus to make us bold, and Go Big. What is one tangible step you can take toward each this week?
