Main Idea

Pride is defeated through the divine reversal of embracing true humility.

Key Scriptures

Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

1 Peter 5:5-7 ESV

And from that time on Saul kept a close eye on David. The next day an evil[a] spirit from God came forcefully on Saul.
