Main Ideas

Harmony in the home happens when "we" is chosen over "me".

Key Scriptures

Love prospers when a fault is forgiven, but dwelling on it separates close friends. Proverbs 17:9

If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. Matthew 18:15

Run from sexual sin! No other sin so clearly affects your body as this one does. For sexual immorality is a sin against your body. 1 Corinthians 6:18

So if you are presenting a sacrifice at the altar in the Temple and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you, leave your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. Matthew 5:23-24

Start doing.

- What is one tangible/practical way you will show kindness to your spouse this week?
- What is one tangible/practical way you will offer forgiveness and grace this week to your spouse?
