#### **Main Idea**

Your value and your purpose are not contingent on your marital status.

## **Key Scriptures**

The serpent was the shrewdest of all the wild animals the LORD God had made. One day he asked the woman, "Did God really say you must not eat the fruit from any of the trees in the garden?" "Of course we may eat fruit from the trees in the garden," the woman replied. "It's only the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden that we are not allowed to eat. God said, 'You must not eat it or even touch it; if you do, you will die.""

"You won't die!" the serpent replied to the woman. "God knows that your eyes will be opened as soon as you eat it, and you will be like God, knowing both good and evil."

The woman was convinced. She saw that the tree was beautiful and its fruit looked delicious, and she wanted the wisdom it would give her. So she took some of the fruit and ate it. ## Start thinking.

- Read Gensis 3:1-7. Reflect on the phrase "did God really say...". What might Eve have thought about after that question?
- Reflect on the phrase "You won't die!". Think about the impact of that statement, for the first time in human history that someone verbally spoke against God. What were the reprocussions of that interaction between Satan and Eve?

## Start sharing.

- How does our culture buy into the lie that God might not be enough?
- How do we do the same thing?
- Where do we source our information on our value and purpose? What ways do we allow false information to influence the truth?
- Do you struggle with understanding your value and your purpose?

## Start doing.

- What are practical ways you can adjust the volume levels in your life regarding where you take in information on your value and purpose?
- What are practical ways you can encourage people with the love of Jesus, regardless of their marital status?
