Main Idea

One matters most.

Key Scriptures

But seek first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. Matthew 6:33 ESV

 What were the disciples thinking through all of this?
- Why did Jesus touch the man first? What does he model by doing so?

Start sharing.

- How have you been impacted by just one person leaning toward you?
- What excuses can we all sometimes use to keep us from leaning into that one life?

Start doing.

- Pray daily this week that Jesus would reveal the one life, each day, he wants you to pursue for his Kingdom and his righteousness.
- If you know of someone in need, what one thing will you do to pursue them?
